One of my favorite stories from Exodus is Moses and the burning bush. Moses is minding his own business when he sees a bush that is burning but is not burned up. Curiosity gets the best of him, and he decides to go check this out.

As he gets closer, God calls to Moses and tells him to take off his sandals because he is standing on holy ground. God informs Moses that he has heard the cry of his people and now is sending Moses to free them. The first thing out of Moses mouth is a question, "Are you sure you have the right person?" When we look at our own lives, don't we ask the same question? "God, are you sure you have the right person? I'm not good enough. I don't have the training or the skills. What if people don't believe me? What if I'm not able to speak the right words?"

In this story there is one line that resonates with me, and I think all of us when we ask these questions. "I will be with you!" What amazing words spoken by God to Moses and to us as well. God will be with us through the hard times, through our moments of weakness, through our moments of questioning, and through our everyday routine. Later God answers Moses' question about who is sending him. "I AM WHO I AM, I AM has sent you (Exodus 3:14). We all have doubts; we all have questions just as Moses did. May we hear the words of I AM, "I will be with you." I will be with you through the good times and through the bad times, through the times of doubt and questioning. Never forget that as we walk through life God is with us, and may we be the light bringers who point people to I AM.
